Future discussion points:

- The lack of services available to Younger / Contemporary Widows
- DVA's (possible) use of Covert Surveillance on Clients and the effect on Veterans with Mental Health Conditions

ASASA Representative Observations:

- The Younger Veterans Forum is an excellent method to bypass bureaucratic red tape and liaise directly with the decision makers in DVA
- The lead time for submission of discussion points is long; any topics that the ASASA committee, Younger Veterans or the Regiment Advocacy Team wish to submit need to be discussed well in advance
- Dissemination of key points to ASASA members needs refinement
